

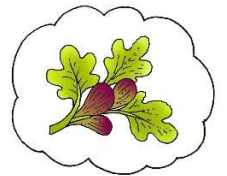


**Love • Respect • Shine**

Many thanks to our parish priests for joining us and to our amazing children who made us all very proud.



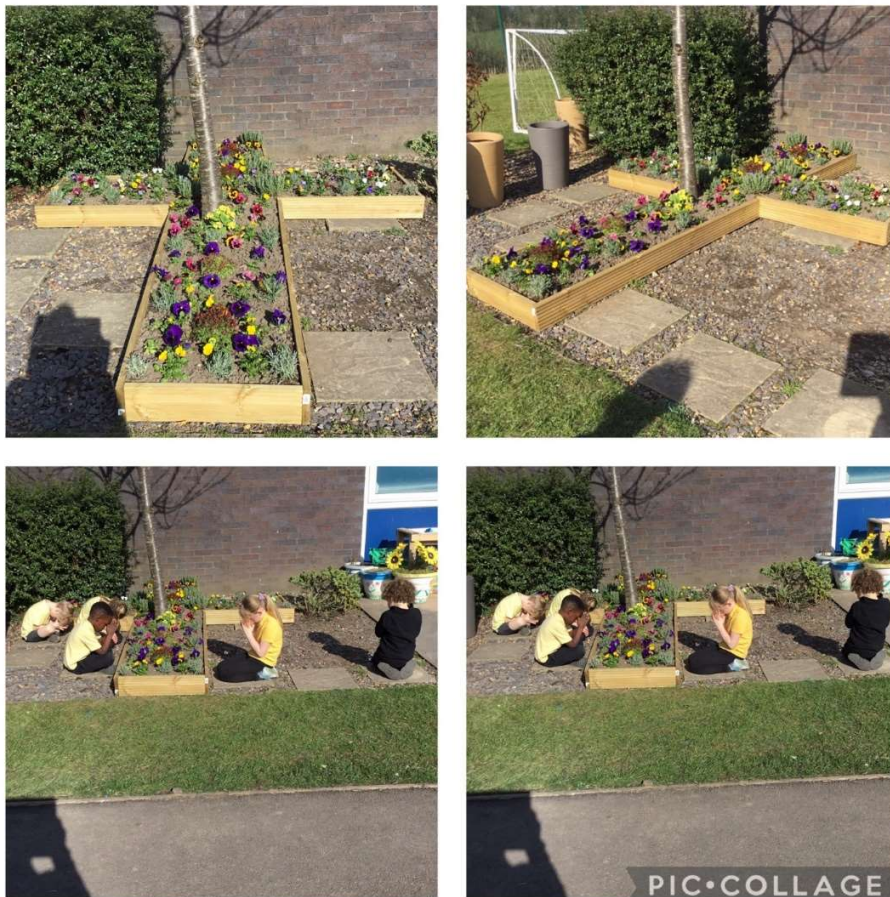
