IMPORTANT REMINDERS:

Breakfast & After School Bookings:

Breakfast Club and After School bookings need to be made <u>24 hours</u> in advance of the child attending the session using the Magic Booking system. This is due to health & safety regulations, staff : child ratios and food preparation requirements. Our clubs are very full and on some days are at full capacity. If your child turns up for a session and is not booked on we may need to turn them away if we do not have a space. If you have any issues with Magic Booking please contact Mrs Hunt <u>wraparaoundcare@cheadle-inf.stockport.sch.uk</u>

Prior to contacting Mrs Hunt please check that your balance is fully paid. **Magic Booking will not let you book another session if there is an outstanding balance OR if the session is full.** Booking can be made a term in advance. We suggest that advance booking is the best way to secure a place to avoid disappointment.

- Please ensure that all items of clothing and snacks are labelled clearly.
- PE trainers/ shoes should be black only with velcro straps please.
- Please do not allow your children to play on the Reception/ Nursery equipment before or after school, this includes the school tricycles and scooters.
- Snacks: We are a healthy school and we ask that children bring in a healthy snack for morning break. Sweets, chocolate or crisps are not allowed. <u>Nuts of any kind</u> are not allowed in school. Please read our Healthy Snack Policy for more information.

We also ask that if you are bringing in grapes or cherries that they are sliced into quarters and the stone is removed. This is to protect children from choking.

We do have a number of children in school with severe allergies and in order to keep them safe at all times certain classes have been asked not to bring in cheese or yoghurts for snack or in lunchboxes. This will be reviewed again just before half term. If your child is in one of these classes you will have been notified
