#### This Week in Assembly:

This week in Assembly, we took time to reflect on the importance of VE Day. We explored why this historical event is significant and spent some time praying for peace around the world.

Throughout the week, we have been learning about VE Day and its impact. We rounded off the week with a special celebration on the school field Thursday afternoon.





#### Year 2:

In Year 2 we learnt about how VE Day was celebrated by investigating different historical sources like videos, photographs and eye witness accounts. We tried dancing the 'Lambeth Walk', listened to some swing music and made flags to wave. The children enjoyed acting out different photographs and guessing what each person might be thinking.

Then we reflected on what their 'hopes for a better world' might be.



#### Year 1:

Children in Year 1 designed a commemorative plate, a war medal and a flag to wave during our special treat in the afternoon. The children enjoyed signing a special VE Day song and learnt lots of facts about the way people celebrated 80 years ago.
