On **Monday 24th June** we will have a 'Time to Shine' Assembly where we will share and celebrate all of the children's achievements.

If you complete an activity that is not in your booklet and you would like to record and share it with us, please record it on the back page.

Please note: The completion of the booklet is not compulsory.

Attendance:

You will have now received a letter with your child's half termly attendance percentage.

If we have concerns about your child's attendance, I will email you separately.

If your child's percentage is below 90% their attendance will also be monitored by the Local Authority Education Welfare Officer

If your child does not attend school regularly they may:

- Struggle to keep up with school work.
- Miss a vital part of a block of work, making it harder to keep up in subsequent lessons.
- Miss out on the social side of school life.
- Find it harder to make and keep friendships - a vital part of growing up.
- Not make the progress they are capable of.

Attendance will impact on outcomes for children. If your child's attendance is less than **95%** they will not make as much progress as their peers throughout the year and will often be working below age related expectations. 90% attendance at this time in the year equates to 10 full days of absence which means that 10 hours of english and 10 hours of maths have been lost so far this year.

Punctuality

Every minute counts!

If we have concerns about your child's punctuality, you will have also received an email this week.

All pupils are expected to be at school by 8:50am ready for the start of the day at 8.55am. Registers will be taken at 9.10am. If a child arrives after 9.10am they will be marked present but arriving late.

Classroom doors will be locked at 9.10am. Parents of pupils arriving after 9:10am must report to the office to provide a reason for their child's lateness. The register will close at 9.30am – pupils arriving after this time will be marked as an unauthorised absence for the morning session.

Arriving late by just a few minutes each day can have a big impact on achievement. It also causes disruption for your child, the teacher and the other children in the class.

PARKING:

The area around our school is becoming increasingly dangerous for our children in the morning and at the end of the school day.

We have had a number of near misses where parents have driven up on the pavement or reversed when turning, and have nearly hit children.

This is not acceptable.

Please can we ask you not to park on double yellow lines or zigzag lines, not to park up on the pavement and to park safely along the roads outside of school.
