PARKING:

As we begin another busy half term, I wanted to take a moment to remind everyone about being considerate when parking around the school premises especially when we have sport's mornings, school trips and assemblies coming up.

Our primary concern is ensuring the safety of all our pupils, families, staff, and local residents. Unfortunately, we are still receiving regular complaints from some of our neighbours regarding inconsiderate parking that has obstructed driveways and caused inconvenience. While I understand the difficulties during drop-off and pick-up times, I must urge you to park legally and responsibly away from the school site.

Please be mindful of the following:

- Do not block residential driveways or park on pavements, as this can force pedestrians, including young children, into the road, putting them at risk.
- Avoid double parking or stopping on the zigzag lines outside the school gates, as this can dangerously impede visibility for other motorists and pedestrians and cause unnecessary congestion.
- Consider parking a short distance away and walking the remaining stretch to avoid congestion directly outside the school.

I recognise that parking can be challenging, but a little consideration can go a long way in fostering a positive relationship with our neighbours and keeping our community safe. Your cooperation in this matter is greatly appreciated.
