Following the recent Air India plane crash in Ahmedabad, we have been keeping all those affected in our prayers this week – the victims, their families, and loved ones.

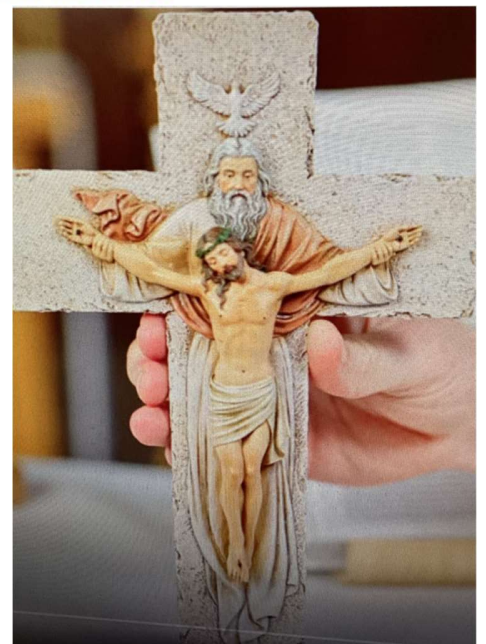

They are also still gratefully accepting **sweet bags, sweets for prizes, cakes, and additional raffle prizes.**

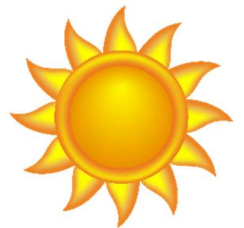
