Science Week:

This week we began our science week in school with a wonderful Assembly led by Mrs Brennan-Sweeney.

A message from Mrs Brennan-Sweeney:

We celebrated the opening of science week with a whole school assembly learning about this year's theme... 'Time.'

We thought about how time can be explored in the world around us, not just by looking at the time, but by observing changes over time. The children showed they understood this type of scientific enquiry by discussing how the seasons change and also by giving examples of day time, night time activities and changes over time. They were also able to discuss how they could observe plants grow which are perfect examples of how we can observe changes over time.

As a 'wow' part to our assembly Anne Mc Clusky joined us to discuss her career in science and chemistry. Anne showed us an experiment and really did wow the children when she turned clear water to pink water and back the clear water! The children spoke about the 'magic'



of this all day and really questioned the science part of such an amazing experiment. It was wonderful to hear the children telling their friends how they thought Anne changed the water.

Thank you Anne for bringing Science alive in our assembly.





Reception:

Reception have had a great time being scientists during science week. They have used their prediction and observation skills to carry out a dancing raisins experiment and have also explored how apples change over time.



Nursery:

Nursery have continued to help our ducks to grow this week during science week. We have also been observing apples to see how they change over time. We have been talking about and drawing what we can see.



Year 1:

This week in Science week we have been learning about the life cycle of a variety of animals - and exploring the amazing and sometimes unbelievable changes that happen to them.

We have also explored the life of naturalist Sir David Attenborough. We discovered that he was always interested in science and this began with him collecting fossils when he was a young boy.

We investigated the many many jobs you can have if you were to become a scientist. These include working

with animals, building bridges and designing objects that fly!

Anyone can be a scientist as long as you are curious and interested in how things work!.

Year 2:

As the theme for Science week is 'time' we have been investigating pendulums. We found out what they are and what they might be used for. We then made our own pendulums and investigated what happened when we made the string longer or shorter or if we added extra weight. It was a great opportunity to show what we know about fair testing and observing changes through investigations. We had some very interesting discussions.



Year 2 Trip:

Year 2 had a wonderful time at Z Arts in Hulme on Tuesday. They learnt how to walk like penguins and bears in a drama workshop, made some amazing versions of the Odd Dog Out in art and hunted for clues in the Rob Biddulph 100 Story Hotel.

All of the children were beautifully behaved and a credit to us all. A huge thankyou to all of the Year 2 staff and helpers for making this possible.

We had two wonderful mornings on Thursday and Friday at Nursery and Reception Sport's Mornings. The sun shone and so did our children!

Every child tried their very best and had a smile on their face throughout all of the races. Thankyou Reception & Nursery parents for joining us and for supporting the children.
