## Summer Reading Challenge



All Cheadle Catholic pupils are invited to take up the Summer Reading Challenge.

### What is the Summer Reading Challenge?

The Summer Reading Challenge encourages children to keep reading during the school summer holidays – and to enjoy reading anything they like! Children aged 4-11 are invited to set a reading goal and collect rewards for their reading. It's completely **FREE** to take part.

### Why should my child sign up?

- They will be **better prepared to return to school** in the autumn.
- The Challenge **supports the move into a new year group**.
- Becoming more independent in their reading boosts children's **confidence and self-esteem**.
- The library provides **free access** to books and fun family activities all through the summer.
- Library staff are on hand to offer support and book recommendations.

Your child will be part of a UK-wide programme developed by The Reading Agency and delivered in partnership with the public library network.

### School Uniform:

#### Uniform Autumn 2024

As a school we continue to make a concerted effort to ensure all children and families are very clear on our policy regarding school uniform and we would like to thank all the families that have worked in partnership with

the school to ensure their child arrives at school in the correct uniform, which includes no nail varnish or jewellery. Simple analogue watches are allowed.

Earrings (including studs) are not permitted. If you wish your child to have their ears pierced, we would encourage this to happen at the beginning of the summer holidays to allow the holes to heal as they will be asked to remove them for school. New studs must be covered for up to six weeks. After that the ears should have healed or medical attention needs to be sought.

**Shoes:**

All pupils can wear **black velcro trainers** as part of the uniform rather than shoes. This means that parents will only need to buy one pair of footwear for the year. We ask that the trainers are plain black (no brands eg Adidas and are velcro and not laces.)

**Yellow polo shirt:**

The yellow polo shirts may also be worn for PE. Parents do not need to buy a separate PE T shirt.

The shops are already full of uniform ready for the new school year – before the current one has even finished! Please see the details below before buying to ensure that your child returns to school in the correct smart uniform in September.
