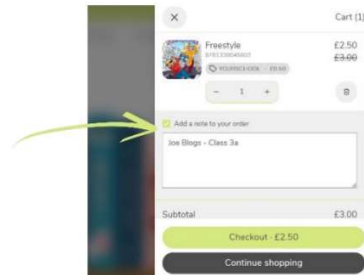
also free as they will all be delivered to school once the book fair closes (we are expecting them to be delivered the following week, so in plenty of time for Christmas if you want to start shopping early!)

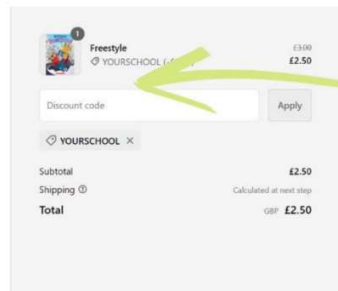

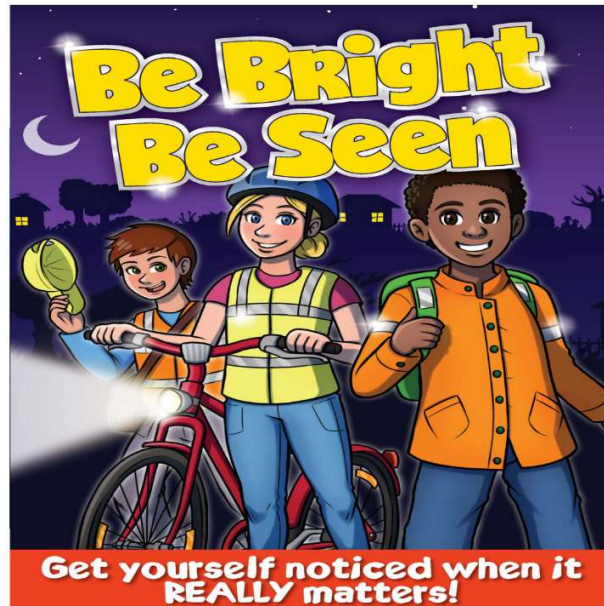
