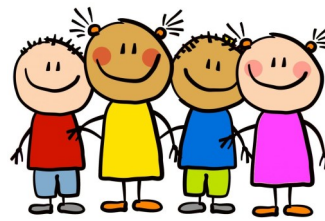

- To know some ways that Christians prepare for Jesus at Christmas during the season of Advent.

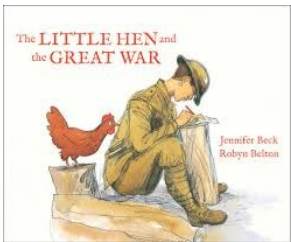


History

English



- We will take part in lots of role-play and drama to help our imaginations and fuel our descriptive writing skills.
- We will be writing poetry, setting descriptions, postcards and letters.
- We will be writing exclamation sentences with exclamation marks.

Maths



- To be able to add a 1 digit number to a 2 digit number crossing 10.
- To be able to subtract a 1 - digit number from a 2-digit number crossing ten.
- To add 2, 2-digit numbers.
- To count money in pounds and pence, using notes and coins.
- To compare amounts of money, find totals and find change.
- To recognise, make and add equal groups.

Science

Our **Science** topic this half term will be called 'Healthy Me.'

We will be thinking about how we will keep our bodies and our minds healthy by looking at exercise, diet, hygiene, happiness and wellbeing.

DT

In **Design Technology** we will be investigating wrapping paper, cards and gift tags. We will be designing and making our own eco-friendly alternatives.

Computing

We will be learning the functions of the 2paint tool in Purple Mash to create pictures in the style of different artists.

PE

In games children will create their own throwing and catching games. They will develop these by adding a points system and sharing their games with others.
In gymnastics children will perform gymnastic shapes and link them together, use shapes to create balances and link travelling actions and balances using apparatus. They will also demonstrate different shapes, take off and landings when performing jumps.
