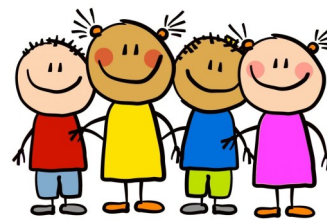




Year 1—Autumn Term 2A

- Use adjectives to improve our sentences.

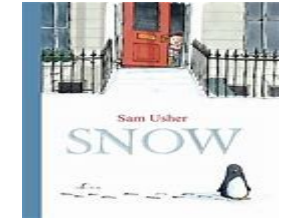
