- This week is Children's Mental Health Week. We will be thinking about things and people that are special to us and discussing our own talents and what makes us special.

Literacy



- This week we will look at a range of Non-fiction texts about people who help us. E.g. doctors, nurses etc.
- We will learn new sounds, read and write simple words and sentences in our phonics groups.
- We will draw and write about what makes us special.
- We will write tags for CVC objects.

Mathematics



- We will focus on making 6, 7 and 8 using a bit. We will use Numicon shapes to show that 6 is made of 5 and 1 more, 7 is made of 5 and 2 more etc. We will then use 10s frames and double sided counters to show the numbers.
- We will play a subitising dice game in pairs.
- We will play an Evil Pea track game in pairs.
- We will match the numbered emergency vehicles to the matching house numerals.
- Maths of the day- we will focus on number recognition by playing hopscotch. We will also use chalk to write our numbers to 10.
