Literacy



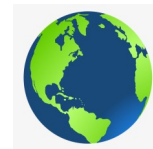
- Phonics– We will learn new special friends and practise our reading and writing in our phonics groups.

Mathematics



- We will focus on measuring. We will discuss the things we might use to help us measure something. We will use string to measure around our heads, see how many cubes long our string is. We will then use our string to make our own Euro's headband.
- We will be finding and counting a range of football objects.
- We will use pegs and peg boards to make flag patterns.
- Maths of the day: we will be counting how many goals we can score in our own penalty shoot out. Which team scored the most?
