RE



We will introduce our new topic 'Ends of the Earth'. We will learn about what happened when Jesus appeared to the Apostles.

Maths



We will complete our work about multiplication and division and practise problem solving and reasoning with multiplication and division.

English



This week we will continue to read 'Once upon a Dragon's fire' by Beatrice Blue. We will create sentences using adjectives and conjunctions.

PE



PE will be on Thursday and Friday. On Thursday the children will be learning tennis skills. On Friday we will begin our outdoor athletics lessons.

Shared Reading



This half term we will be looking at the features of traditional stories and the language they use starting with 'Peach Boy' A traditional tale from Japan.

Geography



We introduce our enquiry question 'Where in the world is Japan and would it be an exciting place to visit?'. We will use our enquiry triangle of 'I see, I think and I wonder...' to explore some of the different geographical features.

We are going to create our own 'pumpkin polka dot' art based on the work of Yayoi Kusama.

This week we will discuss how medicines can be harmful. We will find out what other harmful substances there might be around our homes and how we can keep safe around them.

Science
