<u>RE</u>  We will listen to the story of the Creation and respond by considering why it is important to care for God's World. We will listen to the story of Noah and remember God's promise to all living creatures in the sign of the rainbow.	<u>Maths</u>  We will continue to look at place value of numbers within 100. We will begin to partition numbers in different ways. We will use number lines to demonstrate our understanding of place value on a number line.
<u>English</u>  This week we will begin to read the book 'Cloudy with a chance of Meatballs' by Judi Barrett. We will be exploring the setting through drama and imagining what it might be like to live there.	<u>Shared Reading</u>  We will continue to read 'Clem and Crab' and make predictions about what might happen next in the story. Then we will think about the different emotions Clem has throughout the story.
<u>Science</u>  We will be finding out what a seed needs to grow and thrive by investigating what happens when a seed is deprived of light, soil, water or warmth.	<u>Geography</u>  We will be learning to use a compass in the playground to find North, South, East and West. We will be thinking about how weather changes throughout the year and how our surroundings change with the seasons.
<u>Computing</u>  We will continue to use 2go to design an algorithm to complete more than one step of a route at once. <u>Internet Safety:</u> We will talk about personal information and what is safe to share on line.	<u>PE</u>  Our PE days are on Thursday and Friday. The children will be allowed to wear their PE kits in school on these days. Friday will be outdoor PE where we will practise ball skills. On Thursday we will begin our gymnastics lessons. All children will need shorts on a Thursday for gymnastics lessons.
