Year 2 - Week Beginning 17.3.2025



We will listen to the story of the Last Supper and think about how the sharing of bread and wine links to Mass. We will learn about the times when Jesus disciples let him down and how he always forgave them.

Computing



In computing this week, we will continue to use the program '2 paint a picture'. This week we will learn about and recreate the work of Mondrian using vertical and horizontal lines and primary colours.



In PE we will be working on our team building skills by creating games to play and working as a team. we will develop our leadership, listening and collaboration skills.

We will continue our 'Great Fire of London' dance, linking sequences of movement to music.



We will be learning how to put a buttress on a cereal box to make a secure structure.
