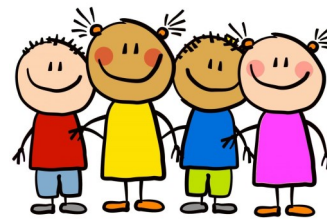
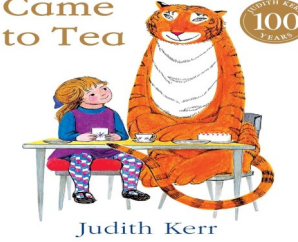

R.E. - Prophecy and Promise

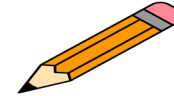
- Know that in the Annunciation God called Mary and she said 'yes' to His call and why this makes Mary important for Christians.
